### Accommodation

Les Cerises is situated in a quiet hamlet near the village of St Gonnery, Morbihan, Brittany. The house is part of a converted farmhouse. There is a garden and ample parking space, surrounded by fields and well away from the main road.

### Ground Floor

Living room and dining room. Kitchen with gas cooker, dishwasher, microwave, fridge and freezer. Shower room with wash basin and toilet. Use of washing machine.

### First Floor

Shower room with wash basin and toilet. Four bedrooms, two with double beds, one with two single beds and one with a single bed. A cot is also available.

### Outdoors

Patio table, chairs and barbecue available. Table tennis, pool table and badminton. Splash pool for Summer months.

### Immediate area

There is a wood and stream nearby, and the villages of St. Gonnery and Hermonstoir are a kilometre away.



The area provides easy access to the seaside resorts of the Bay of Morbihan to the south, the Granite Coast of the Cote D'Armor to the north and St Michel to the East.

### St Gonnery

Pretty village with shops, bakers, bar, creperie, church, lake and tennis courts. Petrol and relais station with pool tables. Outside the village is Thereses', an excellent restaurant.

### Hemonstoir

Village with shops, bar, lake etc.

### Loudeac

Modern town with good shops and supermarkets. Indoor swimming pool, parks and lakes, riding school etc.

### Pontivy

Once the capital of Brittany with lots of shops and supermarkets. Chateau, canal, sports, outdoor pool and tourist centre.

A short distance away there are the lakes of Guerledan which provide safe bathing, sandy areas, water sports and boat trips. For walkers and bird watchers, the Blavet Valley is a short drive away, and is of particular interest.



### Historic Interest

**Josselin**, a beautiful town with its famous cathedral, chateau and toy museum.

**Carnac** and its standing stones.

**Moncontour**, a mediaeval town which hosts a yearly pageant.

**Les Salles**, a living museum.

**Vannes**, with its cathedral, marina and excellent market.

**Bon Reponse Abbey** with its seasonal performances.
